Did you know...?

- most drownings to babies happen in the bathtub
- infant bath rings and bath seats are not safe – your baby could slip into the water



Remember...

- be within arms' reach of your child at all times
- always stay right beside your child when they are in the bathtub. If you have to leave, take your child with you
- a young child can drown in as little as 1 inch (2.5 cm) of water in just a few seconds



Supervising your child at all times can save a life!
