# **Coming from Out-of-Town?**



### **BC Family Residence Program\***

Provides travel subsidies for any eligible out-of-town BC family with a child at BC Children's Hospital at no cost

### Travel Assistance Program (TAP)\*

Provides travel subsidies for eligible BC residents who must travel outside their home community for medical services

- Click on Information for BC Residents for information about eligibility and the application process



### **Health Connections\***

Provides travel subsidies for rural BC residents who must travel outside their home community for medical services

- Click on the region or health authority that applies to you for more information about the services provided in that area
- Health Connections is separate from, but complementary to the Travel Assistance Program – sometimes you will use both programs

### Parking

- Check out the rates and long-term parking options online: www.bcchildrens.ca/YourVisit/parking.htm
- Park inside the gated parking areas to avoid running back out to the meter
  if your appointment is taking longer than expected the rates are the same
  as the metered areas
- Consider using the free valet service available at BC Children's Hospital main entrance from 10am to 4pm, Monday to Friday
