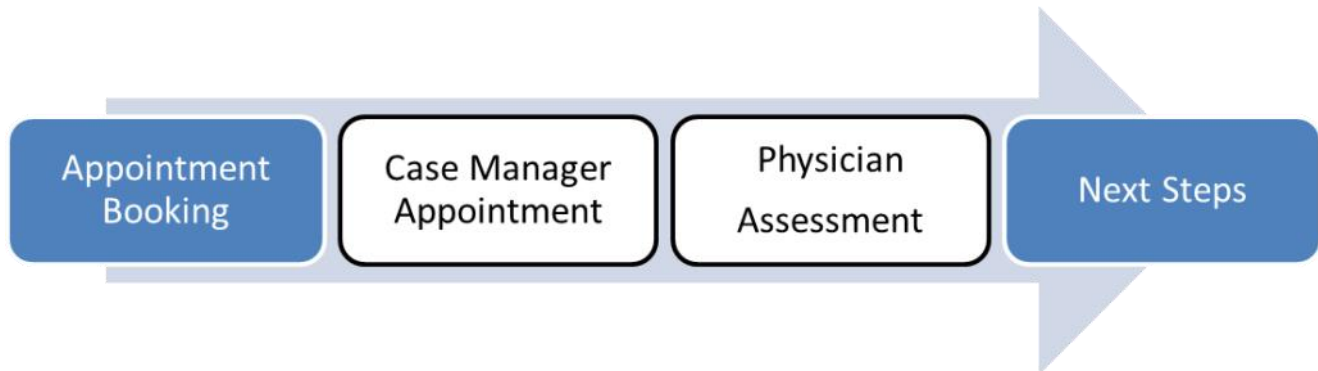


Your CDBC Appointment: Case Manager & Physician



Who is a CDBC Physician?

A medical doctor with knowledge and expertise in developmental and behavioural conditions in children and youth. Trainees may also be participating in the assessment.

Who is a CDBC Case Manager?

A nurse who helps to coordinate your child's /youth's care through their CDBC assessment process; a point of contact throughout the assessment process.

Who should come to this appointment?

- The child and legal guardian. Immediate caregivers may wish to attend the appointment.

What will the appointment involve?

- The appointment will include an interview with parents and the child/youth, as well as possible assessments related to thinking, learning, and behaviour. Medical history and physical examination will be included.
- A review of the need for additional assessment through CDBC or other appropriate assessments

What should I bring to the assessment?

- Any documents requested by your case manager.

How long will the assessment take?

- Up to 30 minutes with the Case Manager and 90 minutes with the Physician.

What happens after the appointment?

- Find the medical report at www.myehealth.ca when your access code arrives in the mail.
