Is there anything else you need to know about the referral process?	The first step in the referral process is a visit to the child's family physician, who must then send a written referral to our intake coordinator. Please note that not all referrals are accepted as appropriate for this clinic. Sometimes these referrals will be redirected to community-based resources. If the referral is accepted for assessment, an information package that includes a questionnaire and consent forms will be sent to the family.
