You are being invited to participate in a Patient Journey Mapping session.

The Patient Journey Mapping session will map out the services and care you received from the Cystic Fibrosis (CF) Clinic at BC Children's Hospital. This will help us learn what worked well and what can be improved. We are specifically interested in understanding the time in between clinic visits (preparations to clinic, follow up recommendations, routine care in between).

The Patient Journey Mapping session will be in person, on campus and will include approximately 4-5 staff members and up to 10 family participants.

All information shared at the session will remain confidential. The session will take approximately one half day and you may be familiar with some of the people in the room and others you will not know.
