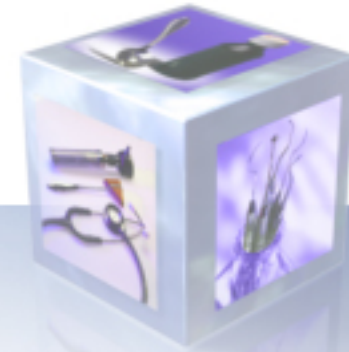


Supporting PHSA's Strategic Directions: Key Initiatives



1	New Academic Health Centre Site Redevelopment	In building the new AHC, we will apply an evidence based design process to promote quality and safety, increase operational efficiency and contribute to and support teaching and research.
2	Collaborative Areas of Innovation	The Collaborative Innovation Program will fund leading edge knowledge creation in child health and development by new collaborators, will improve the health and well being of children in BC, Canada and the world and will contribute to the sustainability of the health care system.
3	Child Health Quality Resource Centre	We will create a child health quality resource centre to support quality, outcomes and evidence based practice as it relates to service delivery – on site, provincially, nationally and internationally.
4	Provincial Child Health Framework	We, with and through Child Health BC, will collaborate with partners in the ministries, from regions and community and with our academic partners to inform a child health framework.
5	Child Health Information Strategy	We will develop a child health clinical information strategy to advance interdisciplinary best practice on site, support clinical research, and inform education and support community service delivery
6	Advancing the Academic Health Science Model	We will articulate a new academic model which will lead education and research into the future and which will recognize the need to include a focus on global strategies to improve child and youth health.
