Definitions

H&P—Include BP, growth charts, Tanner Stage

Biochem—Urinalysis, BUN, creat, LFTs, Mg, Ca, PO4, ferritin

VMA/HVA—If positive at diagnosis

Echo—If received anthracyclines

GFR—If received cisplatin, nephrotoxic meds, had a nephrectomy or XRT to abdo/pelvis

MIBG—Only if suspicious

Audio—If received cisplatin. Can be done in own community. Only continue beyond 12 months if abnormal

Serology—Measles, mumps, rubella, CMV, EBV, VZV, HIV, HSV, hepatitis B & C, tetanus, polio
