

Summary at Entry to Follow-Up Clinic

Patients should be referred to follow-up clinic at 6-12 months after treatment dependent on number of active problems.

Initial History:

- Symptoms, duration
- Initial exam
- Initial investigations

Diagnosis:

- Stage
- Pathology
- Immunophenotype, Cytogenetics, Molecular Genetics

Treatment:

- Protocol – On Study Yes/No
- Drugs – List all drugs
- Cumulative total: Anthracyclines
Ifosfamide, cyclophosphamide
Cisplatin, carboplatin
Bleomycin
- Surgery – Date, Surgery, Surgeon, CVCs, G-tube, etc
- Radiation – Dose, Location
- Other Treatment
- Blood Transfusions – Obtain list from Blood Bank

Problems During Treatment (**Bold if unresolved**)

- Significant infections
- Treatment toxicity
- Psychosocial

Status at Time of Referral

- General Health – Height, Weight, Nutrition, Immunizations, Viral Status
- School level and achievements
- Family status

Anticipated Future Problems

Consider:

Cardiac	Renal
Growth / Development	Pulmonary
Endocrine: Thyroid	Bones / Joints
Sex Hormones	Neurologic
Growth	Psychologic
Fertility	Education / Social
Second Malignancy	Eye
