

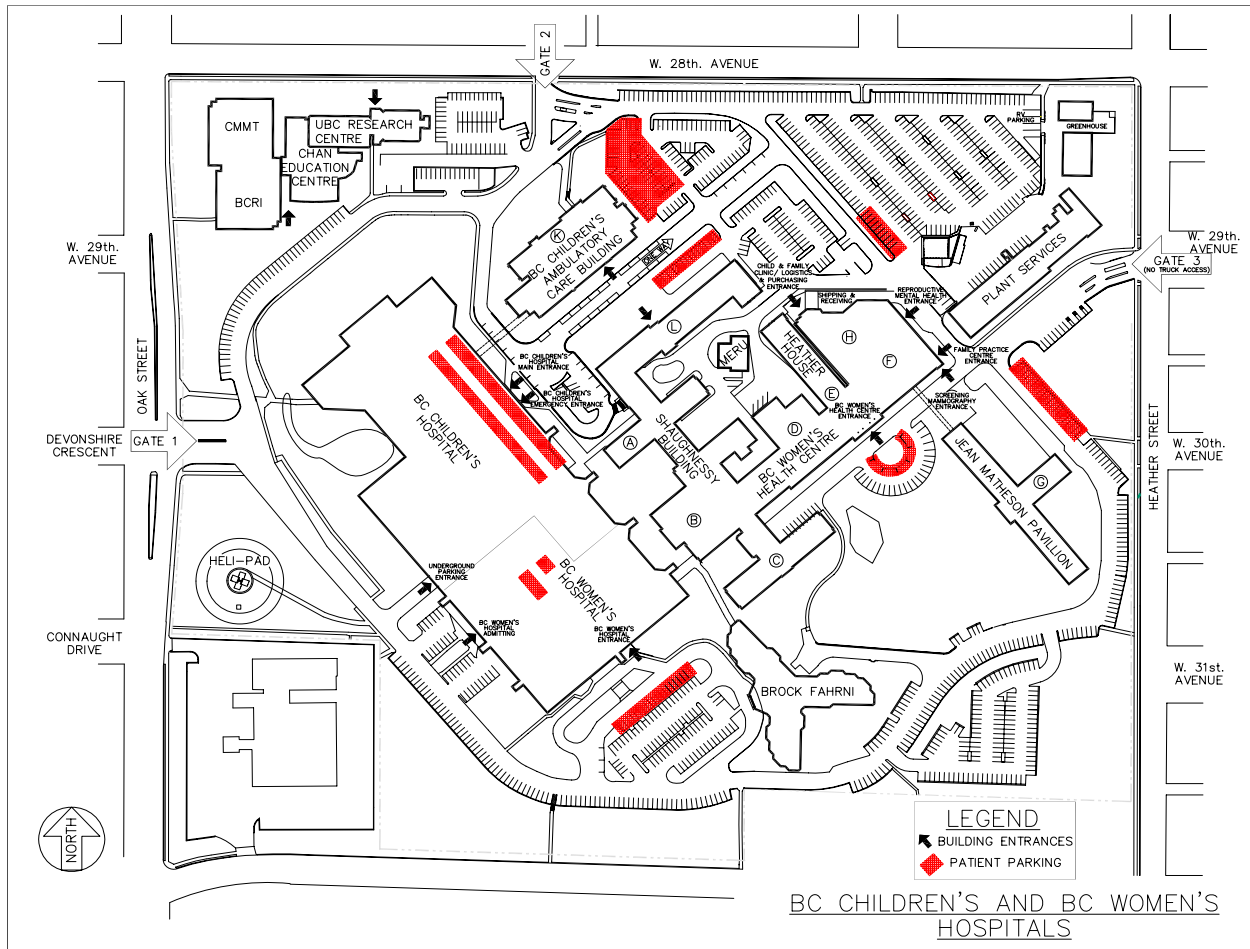
# Patient Parking

## BC Children's Hospital and BC Women's Hospital & Health Centre

Our Oak Street site has designated "Patients Only" parking for patients and families to help ensure you can attend appointments. You can park in any of our 1,800 stalls that's not specifically reserved for physicians at any time of day or night.

Even with over 140 stalls set aside for patient-only parking, finding a parking spot can be a challenge on our busiest mid-week clinic days. We recommend that you arrive early to ensure you make your appointment on time. For more parking information, call (604) 875-2086 during office hours.

## “Patient Only” Parking Locations (8 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. weekdays)

Patients can use these spaces at any time. Staff may **not** use them 8 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. weekdays.

### Ambulatory Care Building

- east end of building: 42 spaces (5 handicapped stalls)
- In front of L block (across road from the Ambulatory Care Building main entrance): 12 spaces (5 handicapped stalls)
- one-hour parking meters for patient drop-off and pick-up only: 42 (2 handicapped stalls)

### BC Children’s Hospital main building

- underground parking: 63 spaces (7 handicapped stalls). *Clearance in the underground parking lot is only 2 metres.*

### Emergency Department

- 7 patient parking spaces (2 handicapped). *Please register your vehicle at the Emergency Department reception desk.*

### BC Women’s Hospital

- underground parking: 12 spaces (4 handicapped stalls) *Clearance in the underground parking lot is only 2 metres.*
- main entrance: 15 spaces (2 handicapped stalls)
- Labour & Delivery (Admitting) entrance: 7 spaces

### BC Women’s Health Centre

- across from main entrance: 6 spaces with 3 hour limit (4 handicapped stalls)

### Family Practice/Breast Screening

- on east ring road: 13 spaces including 2 spaces for Screening Mammography (2 handicapped stalls)

### Psychiatry Building

- northeast corner 30 spaces (2 handicapped stalls)

## Longer term parking options

**Note:** we are not able to offer refunds for parking passes.

For those coming to the hospital often, we offer the following parking passes through our automated pay stations located in parking lots throughout our site. Please note these parking passes are not for sale at cashiers booths:



- 1-week pass \$35
- 1-month pass \$55

Insert your “entry ticket” into the machine to activate the menu. Pay with cash or credit card. VISA and MasterCard accepted.

There are two other passes that are available for families:

- Family one-day “green sticker” pass \$4.50 per day

This one-day parking pass is included with the Preferred Accommodation package. If you leave the site more than once, you will need to purchase an additional parking pass or pay at the cashier booth when exiting again.

- Family 30-hour pass \$50

This multiple hourly pass is for multiple clinic visits. The maximum daily charge is five hours and the pass is valid until the time is used up. Purchase the 30-hour pass at the cashier’s office in the BC Women’s Hospital main lobby from 8 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. weekdays.

## RV Parking

There are three RV spaces for immediate family of admitted patients, which must be reserved no more than three business days in advance. The fee includes parking for your RV plus one vehicle. RV parking is generally limited to four weeks. Call (604) 875-2086.

- RVs may not be parked without prior authorization.
- A vacant site does not mean the site is available.
- RVs parked without prior authorization may be towed at the owner’s expense.
- RVs and vehicles are parked at the owner’s risk.

**Once you have a reservation, purchase your RV passes from an automated pay station.**

- 1-night: \$15 (purchase from staff at parking booth)
- 1-week: \$105 (purchase from automated pay station)
- 1-month: \$265 (purchase from automated pay station)

Please display parking pass on the dashboard or front window of your RV.

## Parking Enforcement

All parking lots are patrolled to make sure designated areas are used appropriately. This helps ensure turnover in short-term parking areas to accommodate patient families. If you are a patient or patient family member and you receive a ticket for parking in a Patient Only stall, contact our Parking Supervisor by calling (604) 875-2086 or mail the ticket, with an explanation, to C&W Parking, Room AB100, 4500 Oak Street, Vancouver, BC, V6H 3N1. We will cancel tickets issued by mistake.
