Calling for Help

CALL 911 for a severe emergency: An ambulance will take you to the closest emergency room

For URGENT medical issues, After Hours (5:00 pm - 8:00 am, Weekends, and Stat Holidays)

Call (604) 875-2161 AND ask to page the <u>Oncologist on-call</u>

- Please give the operator your phone number, including the area code
- The doctor will call you back. If you have not received a call back within 10 minutes, please call again

The on-call doctor may not know your child. Please provide the following information:

- Your child's name, your location in the province, and a phone number where you can be reached
- Diagnosis: _____ Date of diagnosis: ______
- Oncologist:______Nurse clinician: ______
- Most recent treatment, blood work results, and current medications

Examples of when to call the On-Call Doctor:

- **FEVER** (38.5 Celsius by mouth or 38.0 Celsius under the arm)
 - Do not give Tylenol, Advil or Aspirin
 - Please apply EMLA cream to the Port (if applicable) and both arms if you are instructed to go to the hospital emergency AND bring the most recent discharge summary
- Reaction to a medication
- > New symptoms, or existing symptoms are getting worse
- > Pain medications aren't working and he/she is in pain
- Bleeding that doesn't stop in 5 10 minutes
- > Nonstop vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Urgent prescriptions ONLY- If you need a prescription phoned in urgently after hours make sure you have the name, address, and phone number of your local pharmacy
