38.5 Celsius or 101 Fahrenheit (by mouth)

OR

38.0 Celsius or 100 Fahrenheit (under the arm)

Do **NOT** give **TYLENOL** (acetaminophen) or **ADVIL** (ibuprofen) or **ASPIRIN**

Call IMMEDIATELY
