


<u>Instructions for Giving Buccal Lorazepam (Ativan) for Seizure Rescue</u>

- 1. Gather supplies and Seizure Action Plan and Medical Alert Information (SAP) form.
- 2. Check the expiry date on the lorazepam (Ativan). If it has expired, do not give. Call parents and 911.
- 3. **Check** the 5 Rights of Medication Administration (refer to the SAP): Right medication (lorazepam/Ativan), Right student, Right time, Right dose, Right route (buccal).
- 4. **Clean** hands and **place glove** on one hand.
- 5. With gloved hand, place lorazepam (Ativan) tablet in student's cheek between the cheek and the gums (buccal pocket) near their back teeth.



6. Gently **hold** the tablet there for 20-30 seconds, giving it time to dissolve.
