


Instructions for Giving Intranasal Midazolam for Seizure Rescue


- Gather supplies and Seizure Action Plan and Medical Alert Information (SAP) form.
- Check the expiry date on the midazolam. If it has expired, do not give. Call parent and 911
- 3. Check the 5 Rights of Medication Administration (refer to the SAP): Right medication (midazolam 5g/ml), Right student, Right time, Right dose (to line marked on syringe), Right route (intranasal). Two trained individuals are required to complete these checks.



4. With needle cap on, attach (twist the needle onto the syringe.




5. Flip (pop) off the cap on the top of the midazolam vial.




6. (a) Pull back on the plunger to the mark on the syringe to fill the syringe with air. *If there is no mark on the syringe, do not give, call 911 and parent/guardian. (b) Remove (pull off) needle cover.




7. Insert needle into the center of the rubber seal of the midazolam vial.



8. (a) Push down on the plunger to push all of the air into the vial. (b) **Ensure** tip of the needle is in the midazolam and pull up on the plunger until it reaches the mark drawn on the syringe.







- 9. (a) Put the cap back on the needle.
- (b) Remove the capped needle from the syringe.
- (c) Have a second person check the 5 rights of medication administration (see #3 above)



10. Attach (twist) the atomizer onto the syringe.





- (b) Place tip of atomizer snugly against one nostril (aim slightly up and outwards towards to top of the ear on same side). Briskly press the plunger to spray half of the midazolam dose into nostril.
- remaining medication into the nostril.
