

CST Student Training Update

CST Cerner Learning Journey for Students

- Students and Clinical Instructors currently at CW or those starting at CW post Go-Live on February 26th, will begin receiving their CST Learning Journeys this week via their academic emails.
- Each Learning Journey includes a sequence of learning activities, with different modalities and levels of specialization, which gives users the tools they need to start working with CST Cerner safely and confidently. Depending on a student's placement destination and type, they are assigned one of the various Learning Journey combinations that aims to deliver training relevant to their placement and how they will integrate the system into their practice. The key activities of a CST Learning Journey are hosted in various CST Cerner curricula on the [LearningHub](#) (accessible via Google Chrome).
- Curriculum for all Non-Provider students (Nursing, Allied Health, Clerks) will consist of eLearning and self-directed online learning (SDOL) specific to their role. They do not attend Work flow reviews (WFRs).
- Instructors who are not staff are welcome to attend WFRs if there is space. This is not required but would be helpful.
- Provider students (Physicians/Residents/MSIs, Nurse Practitioners and Midwives) will be required to complete eLearning, SDOLs, and WFRs.

Clinical areas not going live with CST

- Some students coming to us will be working with clinic areas that are not going live with CST Cerner on February 26. These students will require dual access to both CST Cerner and [LegacyCerner \(PowerChart\)](#) systems.

Non-Provider Student/Instructor CST Training Steps

1. The CST Learning Team accesses placement information in HSPnet and enrolls students/Instructors into their specific CST curriculum.
 2. The CST Learning Team emails learning journeys to each student/Instructor, via their academic email.
 3. Students/Instructors review their learning journey, which contains information and instructions on how to complete training, and begin their CST training using the links provided. Training consists of a minimum of 6 hours of self-directed learning.
 4. Students/Instructors will be given access to CST Cerner for the duration of their placement
- ** Future Students will receive these CST training emails 4 weeks prior to their placement. Schools must have Student/Instructor information into HSPnet at a minimum 6-8 weeks prior to placement.
