Who should come to this appointment?

 Your child and caregiver(s) or parent(s). You may also bring a friend or relative as a support to you.

What will the appointment involve?

- An evaluation of your child's communication, listening, and talking.
- Activities include: following instructions, looking at pictures, and playing games.
- Parent/caregiver questionnaires are used to gain further insight into your child's language and social skills.

How long will the assessment take?

- Typical assessment time for a child under age 6 is 2-3 hours and over age 6 is 3-6 hours.
- There will be the option to take breaks as needed throughout the assessment.

What should I bring to the assessment?

- Snacks or lunch, especially if your child has food allergies or intolerances.
- If your child typically takes medications, please take them as usual.
