### Procedures:

- Diagnostic lumbar punctures
- N.G. tube insertion for home feedings
- G tube button changes
- Catheter specimen for urine C&S
- Bowel clear outs
  - a) oral colonic solutions via N.G.
  - b) fleet enemas
- Immunizations

### Infusion Centre:

- Central Line Care:  
Assessment/accessing/locking  
management of blocked lines  
dressings/blood sampling
- I.V. starts for multiple types of procedures/blood sampling and infusions.
  - Albumin, IVIG, and other blood products
  - The Home I.V. program
  - Antibiotics
  - Methylprednisolone pulse
  - Remicade
  - Pamidronate
  - Cyclophosphamide
  - Iron infusions
  - Aldurazyme
  - Cerezyme
  - Other medications

### Tests:

- Food allergy challenge
- Medication allergy challenge
- PET
- Tensilon

### Preparation and Recovery for:

- Kidney Biopsy
- Upper Endoscopy
- Colonoscopy
- Bronchoscopy
