Who is a CDBC Physician?

A medical doctor with knowledge and expertise in developmental and behavioural conditions in children and youth. Trainees may also be participating in the assessment.

Who should come to this appointment?

- The child and legal guardian. Immediate caregivers may wish to attend the appointment.

What will the appointment involve?

- An assessment that can include interview with child/youth and the use of neurodevelopmental tests, including physical examination.
- A review of the need for additional assessment through CDBC or other appropriate assessments for your child in the community.

What should I bring to the assessment?

- Any documents requested by your case manager.

How long will the assessment take?

- Up to 2 hours.

What happens after the Physician appointment?
