Measurement Guide for Metabolic Assessment, Screening & Monitoring Tool

	Measurement	Technique
1.	Height Height in millimeters between 2 right angles.	 Shoes off Youth standing with heels, back and shoulders in contact with stadiometer Feet together Gently straighten Hold head aligned, with lower portion of eye orbit in line with middle portion of ear
2.	Weight	 Anything heavy off (i.e., headband, shoes, jacket, etc)
3.	Waist Circumference	 Use a flexible tape of adequate length Have the patient stand erect with abdomen relaxed feet 25-30 cm apart, weight evenly distributed, arms loosely at their side Make the measurement horizontally at the line of the umbilicus/ belly button Ask patient to breathe in and then out gently, then take the measurement
4.	Blood Pressure	 Cuff sizes: you know that it is the right cuff size for a child when the dotted line on the cuff rests between the solid lines Have the child sit down & relaxed If the child is wearing heavy clothing then they need to come off or roll the sleeve up The "Artery V" sign needs to be placed on top of the child's arm where the pulse is (inside the arm) Do not talk the child while measuring & ask the child to speak after measurement is finished Note Systolic/Diastolic mmHg on the Metabolic Monitoring Form (e.g. 120/80)

Measurement Guide for Metabolic Assessment, Screening & Monitoring Tool (cont'd)

Notes:

When measuring the height of children with a turban on their heads, please measure from the lowest part of the turban.

- Place a tongue holder or a thin ruler on top of the lowest part of the child's head
- Level it so that it'll be straight
- Pull the stadiometer down
