

Referral Criteria for: Women's Reproductive Mental Health Program

Referral Criteria	
What are the age criteria?	Ages 19 & older
What are the gender criteria?	Female
Who can refer?	A General Practitioner, Midwife, Psychiatrist, Obstetricians and Gynaecologists can make a referral. All referrals MUST also have a General Practitioner listed for continuity of care purposes
Is there a form that needs to be filled out?	The Reproductive Mental Health referral form needs to be filled out.
How do you submit this form?	Referral forms are faxed to the Reproductive Mental Health Program at (604) 875-3115 *Referrals are triaged based on acuity
If there is no form that needs to be filled out, then who does the referrer need to contact?	n/a

Description of target audience	We serve women who are dealing with mental health challenges or disorders such as depression, anxiety, panic disorder, etc. and who are: • pregnant • postpartum (up to 1 year ONLY) • have experienced a perinatal loss (within 1 year) • dealing with infertility • require a pre-pregnancy medication consult • dealing with PMS Age limit 45 yrs. (must attend a group session prior to a one time consultation with a psychiatrist)
Who is the service not appropriate for?	Anyone who does not fulfill the above criteria *Not accepting referrals related to age related perimenopause
Before or after care restrictions or considerations.	n/a
Is there anything else you need to know about the referral process?	Women may find it helpful to read the - "What To Expect During Your First Visit" before their assessment appointment.
